Dear Year 20 RFP Applicant:

Earlier this week, Public Health Solutions notified applicants under the Ryan White Year 20 Request for Proposals whether they had been funded. Yesterday, through a posting on our website, we let all applicants know who had been funded.

We are writing to let you know that on further review of funded proposals, the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) and Public Health Solutions have determined that new programs result in an insufficient number of service locations for Bronx residents in certain service categories. To address this issue, we have decided to fund two additional programs that serve the Bronx, one in the Food and Nutrition Services category and one in the Outreach to Homeless Youth category. We are still reviewing the Transitional Care Coordination category, and will reach a conclusion in the next week. At that time, we will post the new portfolio of funded programs in all three categories.
